JOB SUMMARY:

Electrician 2 employees report to Electrician 3 for work assignments. Duties include but are not limited to completing all tasks assigned by the Electrician 3 and Electrician Supervisor, which may include installing and repairing complex electrical control, wiring, and lighting systems working from a technical blueprint. As the employee’s knowledge and skill develop, the employee’s duties will become more complex and require more judgement.

QUALIFICATIONS:

An Electrician 2 employee will be able to work the scheduled hours. They will be able to read a tape measure, read blueprints, train Electrician 1&2, and follow written and verbal directions and be able to work outdoors when required in all types of weather.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Electrician 1

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Follow instruction from Electrician 3 and Electrician Supervisor
- Ability to instruct other Electrician team members.
- Install, maintain, and repair electrical control, wiring, and lighting systems.
- Reading technical diagrams and blueprints.
- Perform general electrical maintenance.
- Inspect transformers, circuit breakers, and other electrical components.
- Troubleshoot electrical issues using appropriate testing devices.
- Repairing and replacing equipment, electrical wires, and fixtures.
- Follow National Electrical Code, State, and Local building regulations.
- Perform circuit breaker corrective maintenance.
- Maintain good knowledge of heating and air conditioning systems as well as various testing equipment.
- Work irregular hours and overtime when required.
- Create a welcoming work environment.
- Bring a positive attitude each day.
- Other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED SKILLS / ABILITIES

The Electrician 2 employee is expected to work with minimal supervision and a customer centered focus. Able to read blueprints and electrical prints. 3-5 years of experience required. Ability to work standard and extended hours. Show up on time for scheduled shifts. Adhere to OSHA safety standards.

TRAVEL, HOURS OF WORK, & SUPERVISION:

This position normally requires the individual to be physically present at one or more TBB manufacturing location Monday through Friday. This position will report to Electrical 3.

CERTIFICATES, LICENSES AND REGISTRATIONS:

- Current apprentice license preferred.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- 3 years' electrical experience required.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS (including but not limited to):

- Regularly able to work a 12-hour shift standing/walking.
- Regularly able to climb ladders repetitively.
- Regularly able to bend, crouch, twist, pull.
- Regularly able to lift/carry 80 lbs.
- Regularly able to work at a desk for short periods of time.
- Regularly able to work in all types of weather.
